About the project

Our community is excitingly diverse, we speak different languages, come from different places and right now we are all going through a tough time. Bringing languages and cultures together is integral to my work and to my intention to preserve under-represented languages.

I wish to invite your children to contribute to my artistic practice exploring the richness of language by submitting artwork that reflects your household's language/s. My hope is that it may be published into a small booklet to guarantee its longevity. It will be preserved as a permanent public reference resource for use in research, publications, exhibitions, education, lectures, broadcasting, and the internet. **Your artwork will also be considered for shortlisting as part of The Higgins Bedford contemporary Covid19 History archive, as a record of celebrating heroes from our local community.**

.....Here's how it works:

- Draw your COVID 19 hero, it may be a parent, a relative, a friend, or a key worker that has supported you during this difficult time.
- Translate “thank you” and “our heroes” in your language/s and include that in your artwork
- Please complete the form and sign the conditions for use consenting to use your child's artwork and date it where shown.
- Submit a photograph of your artwork no later than **Monday the 20th of July 2020** along with this form to: Email: contact@desireebashi.com

Submission Criteria:

- The work can be in any format, e.g. 2D – watercolour, acrylic, oils, photography, or 3D – sculpture or installation.
- Entries need to be submitted in the form of a digital JPEG photograph (the higher the resolution the better), which may be included in an online gallery. PLEASE DO NOT SEND your artwork as we are NOT ACCEPTING actual works of art at this stage of the project.
- Please DO NOT frame or mount your work. Instructions for this may be given at the end of the project.
- Your artwork will need to meet fair guidelines on appropriate taste and decency and must not contain defamatory or obscene material. Works that may cause offence or encourage breaking the law will not be tolerated, accepted, or displayed by the project leader.
- If you include in your artwork existing text, music, pictures, or other material created or written by someone else then you must state this on the form below or we will not be able to use or broadcast your work. E.g.: if you have included words from a book, poem or play then we need to know the name of the author, the title of the work and the name of the publisher

- This form is valid for the future. If you change your mind and wish to withdraw permission, please contact Desiree Bashi
- If we use artwork of individual people under the age of 18, we will avoid using their name in the accompanying text or caption.
- We will not include personal details such as telephone numbers or addresses in any of our publications.
- E-mail addresses/telephone numbers will only be used to contact you regarding this form, unless otherwise agreed.
- Please note that websites and social media can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the UK where UK law applies.
